Dorothy Cotton Jubilee Singers

Auditions for new singers interested in joining DCJS will take place at First Baptist Church on Wednesday, August 25, from 6:00 – 7:00 pm. Please encourage interested friends to take part!

DCJS rehearsals will begin on Wednesday, September 1, at the Varna Community Center, 943 Dryden Road. The change in venue for rehearsals this fall is motivated by the better ventilation system at the Varna site. We plan to have in-person rehearsals for singers who are vaccinated (see complete description of safety protocols listed below); unvaccinated singers, or those who do not yet feel comfortable joining in-person rehearsals, will be able to join over the internet. The chorus members rehearsing in-person will be divided into two SATB groups, and each group will rehearse for one hour, alternating between 7:00 – 8:00 pm and 8:00 – 9:00 pm time slots. It is important that you register as soon as possible so that we know who will be attending the in-person rehearsals. Student Assistants will be expected to attend both rehearsal times.

Protocols for in-person rehearsals of the Dorothy Cotton Jubilee Singers; Fall 2021

With the high vaccination rates in Tompkins County and among the membership of the DCJS we anticipate resuming in-person rehearsals on September 1. Nevertheless, rates of infection in nearby counties and in other regions of the United States remain high, and there has also been a recent increase in new cases in Tompkins County. About half of the new cases are among people who have been fully vaccinated. With these facts in mind, the Board of Directors, in consultation with Dr. Bill Klepack, Medical Director of the Tompkins County Health Department, has approved the following system of layered protocols for in-person rehearsals for the Fall 2021.

Only vaccinated singers will be allowed to attend in-person rehearsals.

Singers will be required to wear properly-fitted masks¹ when singing indoors.

Singers will maintain appropriate separations of 6 feet, or more.

Singers will not attend rehearsals:

If they have symptoms consistent with COVID-19; or

If they have tested positive for the virus within the past ten days; or

If they have knowingly been exposed to someone who has tested positive for the virus (and not been cleared by a negative PCR test 5 – 7 days after the exposure).;

If they have traveled to areas of substantial or high transmission rates (and not been cleared by a negative PCR test 5 – 7 days after the travel).

Singers are discouraged from close personal contact, including hugs and the shaking of hands.

**Concert Attire of DCJS

<u>All</u> members of DCJS are <u>required</u> to wear our official concert attire when performing as an ensemble, unless told otherwise by our director. New attire (other than tuxedos) are purchased by DCJS and individual items become the property of chorus members when each pays the \$30 fee (scholarships are available) for a new dress or \$20 for a used dress. <u>One of the 3 options</u> listed below must be worn by every chorus member.

- 1) a <u>black tuxedo</u>, <u>white shirt</u>, <u>black bow tie</u>, and <u>black closed-toe dress shoes</u>.
- 2) a <u>long</u> Catherine floor-length <u>red</u>, green or black dress with sleeves (a specific item purchased through DCJS, and <u>black *closed-toe* dress shoes</u>
- 3) **long** Palazzo <u>black pants</u> and a plain <u>black</u> Amanda <u>top</u> with cowl neckline and sleeve, (both specific items purchased through DCJS), and <u>black *closed-toe* dress shoes</u>.

We strive to perform in concert in the tradition of the Fisk Jubilee Singers of the late 1800s (see <u>http://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Fisk_Jubilee_Singers</u>), and therefore informal attire or flashy jewelry (except for a simple necklace of pearls, when possible) is <u>not</u> appropriate.

Rehearsals

In-person rehearsals are Wednesday evenings 7:00 – 8:00 or 8:00 – 9:00 P.M. at the Varna Community Center. Singers are asked to arrive **a few minutes early** for their rehearsal time and to leave promptly to allow the next group to start on time. Important announcements pertaining to the group generally will be made at mid-rehearsal.

Although we want to encourage group members to get to know one another, we also ask that you **do** <u>not</u> talk during rehearsals in order <u>not</u> to disturb the rehearsal process. <u>Always bring a pencil</u> to make Director's notes and/or changes in the music. Also, <u>please turn off your cell phones during rehearsals</u> – texting or checking your phone is distracting to other chorus members.

Other items of importance

Please be sensitive to the allergies of others and <u>do not wear scented products</u> of any kind (deodorants, aftershave, perfume, etc.) to rehearsals or to concerts. Even slight scents can sometimes set off the allergies of people with sensitivities.

We also suggest that individual members bring water with them for their comfort and convenience.
